



Dear Members,

In February, EOEA extended the flexibility to allow assisted living residences to provide limited skilled nursing services. Such services are to be provided in accordance with valid medical orders and by nurses holding a valid nursing license permitting them to perform the services.

Regardless of whether an ALR has provided limited skilled nursing services, all ALRs are required to complete this brief survey. Additionally, this is a new round of data collection; therefore, submission of earlier information that may be similar does not preclude this requirement. This survey will allow EOEA to collect data on whether Massachusetts ALRs are currently providing or plan to provide limited skilled nursing services. The data must be submitted using [this link](#).
